UNIFORMS

With the UIL on Tuesday, Friday's game, going straight into Thanksgiving Break and then the game on the day after Thanksgiving, Mr Goring will allow the uniforms to stay home in between. PLEASE, make sure the uniform gets washed after EVERY use, to prevent possible contamination between the students. They take about 24-36 hours to dry, so please wash immediately after they get home. The uniform moms will still be present at school during the run through before the UIL/FB game, to help with any emergency repairs, lost buttons etc. You can call or text 281-610-3746 with questions about the uniforms. Please make sure your student always transports the uniform to and from the school in the garment bag

Please remember:

1. Wash jacket and bibs inside out
2. Use liquid detergent only, no fabric softener
3. Use cold water cycle
4. Use gentle cycle
5. HANG to dry inside out on separate hangers
6. NO DRYER
7. NO IRON!!

The replacement value of the uniform is \$500!!

Once dry (24-36 hours), place all the items on the hanger correctly:

1. Hang up bibs first, line up seams. Slide bibs on the rod and lock rod in.
2. Hang up jacket so front of jacket is on the same side as the student's name, and zip up.

Return uniforms to uniform room. Parents are not allowed in the building at this time, so please have your student return the uniform to the band hall. Each student has a tag hanging in their section; the uniform goes BEHIND the tag.

BOARD POSITIONS
